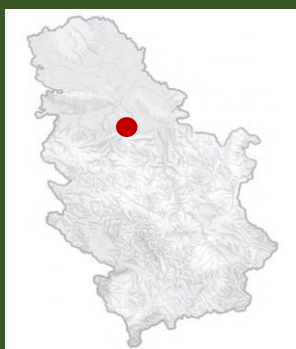


Belgrade City Tour

Departure in front of the hotel at 09:00 a.m. Duration of the tour is 3-4 hours.

Highlights: Kalemegdan Fortress (Roman Well, Belgrade Clock Tower, The confluence Sava into Danube, Communist bunker, The Victor, Despots Tower, Zindan Gate), Knez Mihajlo Street, Congregational Church, Patriarch Palace, The Residence of Princess Ljubica, Republic Square, National Theater, National Museum, Nikola Pasic square, City Assembly of Belgrade, City library, Church of Saint Sava.
