


On a tame Besna kobila Mountain



Besna kobila (Mad mare) Mountain belongs to the highest mountains in Serbia. It is located in the southeastern part of Serbia, not far from Vranje and near the border with Bulgaria. It belongs to the group of Rhodope Mountains, so it mostly consists of granite and crystalline slates. The highest peak of Besna kobila Mountain bears the same name as the mountain itself. From the top, on a nice day, there is a view of Šara Mountain, Prokletije, Pirin, Rila, Kopaonik,...

TOUR PLAN

Departure in front of the hotel at 7:00 a.m. Driving on the highway to Vladičin Han and the main road through the village of Korbevac near Vranjska Banja Spa to Kriva Feja and the mountain lodge "Besna Kobila" located at 1461 m.

The road through the virtues of Southern Serbia, so-called "The Russian road" was built by the Kuban Cossack division almost a century ago. Many of the capable Russian builders gave their lives in the process, because the work was exhausting, and the terrain was inaccessible and mountainous. The Russian road starts from the village of Korbevac and reaches Kriva Feja, and then on macadam, over Besna kobila Mountain, through untouched nature, leads to the city of Bosilegrad. The total length of this section is about 70 km. Monuments to the Cossacks were erected in the village of Korbevac and on Besna kobila Mountain, in memory of what they did and gave to the Serbian people.

After a short break at the mountain lodge, start hiking to the peak of Besna kobila (1923 m), via the peak of Musulj (1777 m). The path to the top is not technically demanding, it is 5 km long and can be crossed in about two hours of easy walking. Return by road to the mountain lodge. Lunch break in the mountain lodge. Departure for Niš. Arrival in Niš in the evening. The end of the program.

Price per person: 30€ (in RSD equivalent)

Price includes: Transportation, English speaking guide, guiding service, travel organization expenses.

Price does not include: Food, individual expenses.

DON'T FORGET TO BRING: Sneakers, a few pairs of socks, T-shirts, a hooded waterproof parka, sweatshirt, back up clothes and shoes, sunglasses, a cap, suntan cream. It is also recommended to take candy bars, nibbles, refreshing beverages and water. Put everything into a small backpack.

NOTE: This program is based on at least 6 applied people. If there occurs a change on the monetary market, commodity market and services, if there are not enough travelers, the organizer retains the right to correct the price, change or cancel the program at least 3 days before the beginning of the program.

According to the Serbian Law on Tourism (Article 79), for one-day excursions (trips shorter than 24 hours), protection is not provided in terms of travel guarantee.
